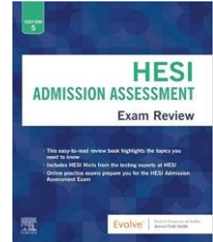

HESI APPS (HESI A2) are available on Smartphones. Some apps are free; others have a cost. You Tube has very helpful videos on the HESI – Subject (grammar, math, vocabulary, reading, etc.).

**Register Online via Student Portal**

Students must first apply for college admission, then will be eligible to register for the NAT 100 examination online at <https://my.hfcc.edu/students>. A \$50 testing fee will be posted to your student account, payable at the time of Registration.

**NAT 100 Scoring Requirements**

1. Minimum score of 80 or higher on Math, Reading, Vocabulary and Grammar is required.
2. You are allowed two attempts every 12 months.
3. Students unsuccessful on their first test may choose in their second testing attempt to only take those subject areas where a score of 80 was not achieved in their first attempt.

**Location of the NAT 100 Exam**

1. The exam location will appear when you register for the exam.
2. One week (approximately) before the exam date you will receive an email from the Proctor informing you of important information about the exam. In this email you will be asked to create an account on Evolve.Elsevier.com.
3. Students need to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the exam to begin the log-in process.
4. Photo ID is required. Driver's license, state ID, anything with your photo on it will suffice.
5. No cell phones or personal items allowed in the testing area.
6. Scrap paper and pencils will be provided.
7. Calculators are embedded in the exam.
